Tax Credit

Could you use \$1,500?

The government is offering a tax credit of up to \$1,500 for purchasing high efficiency appliances such as air conditioners and heaters. No cash out of pocket is required. This offer expires in December 2010, but the government can quickly change its requirements and qualifications, so act now to ensure that you are eligible.

To be eligible for the full \$1,500 tax credit, simply have Aire Serv replace your current heating and air conditioning system with a new, high-efficiency system that qualifies. By installing a qualifying geothermal heat pump, you can receive a credit of up to 30% of the installed cost of geothermal heating, ventilation and air conditioning equipment.

PA Heating Rebates

Starting April 21, 2010, Pennsylvania residents will be eligible to receive rebates on purchases of qualifying high efficiency home heating equipment. Products that qualify will be non-electric ENERGY STAR-qualified water heaters, furnaces, and boilers.

Please note that this program offers rebates only on heating equipment. If you are looking for rebates on other appliances such as washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc. please refer to the Tax Credit offer above.
