Organize your move

Common household articles should not be packed:

- Any kind of aerosol can
- Hair sprays
- Shaving creams
- Deodorants
- Household cleaners
- Insecticides
- Tarnish removers
- Car cleaners

Other flammable articles include:

- Paints (oil base)
- Gasoline
- Kerosene
- Naphtha
- Tar remover
- Paint thinners (turpentine lacquer remover or mineral spirits)
- Bleach
- Muriatic acid
- Auto batteries
- Any type of acid

- Propane tanks
- Oxygen tanks
- Cleaning fluids
- Lighter fluid
- Matches
- Ammunition
- Chlorine granules or powder
- Any other type of combustible
